#### HIGH BILL CHECK LIST

Verify the reading on your meter by reading it left to right and ensuring it is correct. It will be slightly higher than the current reading on your bill.

The biggest culprit of a high water bill is a leaky toilet. We provide free leak detector tablets, or you could simply use food coloring. Drop a tablet in the tank of the toilet and wait 20 minutes. If the dye has seeped into the bowl at all your toilet is leaking and should be repaired immediately as any leaks can become quite costly.

If you have a sprinkler system you should be aware of exactly how much water you are using. Take a reading before and after the sprinkling cycle. Subtract the start read from the end read to get the consumption of your daily usage. Multiply that by the number of times you water weekly. Now multiply your weekly consumption by 12 for your total sprinkling usage per quarter.

IT IS NOW MANDATORY THAT SPRINKLER SYSTEMS BE **EQUIPPED WITH A MOISTURE** SENSOR. THIS HELPS YOU, THE CONSUMER, SAVE ON YOUR OUTSIDE WATERING.
